*Economics majors will have a total of five Upper Division electives: two Economics Advanced Electives and three Economics Standard Electives:

- The Economics Advanced Electives are: Econ 103, 104, 105, 109, 113, 121, 122, 125, 136, 141, 142, 143, 146, 147, 150, 151, 152, 166, 171, 172A, 172B, 173A, 173B, 174, 176, 178, and Math 194 (refer to the course description for required prerequisites).
- The Economics Standard Electives are: any 4-unit Economics course numbered 100-199.
Note: core courses cannot be used to satisfy this category.
