LETTER FROM THE DIRECTOR

Now in its second year, The Economics Industry Engagement program has continued to grow in its reach and impact, fostering new connections between current UC San Diego students and talented alumni.

For students new to Economics at UC San Diego, this program has provided career resources to set them up for success in their first and second years – we recognize these are pivotal times to begin the critical work of building connections and learning soft skills. Resources like these allow them to gain a stronger foothold for job placements. Students can now access a list of internship programs and offerings categorized by class standing eligibility, connecting their academic understanding to realworld experiences.

Quarterly networking and professional development events have given students the opportunity to meet directly with alumni and recruiters. Nearly 500 students have attended our events in year two, a 17% increase from year one. Building on previous successes, we are continuing to host quarterly networking and talent connection events that have brought together alumni and students, creating a robust community to help get students hired.

Looking to the future, we plan to incorporate a new fall welcome event that will connect student organizations, alumni and employers in a dynamic engagement to foster early career-planning. As an additional resource, a year-by-year career development checklist is being developed for Economics students. We hope to encourage our bright scholars to utilize their time at UC San Diego wisely and inform them of important timelines for procuring internships and enhancing their career development. The career conference we are holding in January 2025 will feature some of our most distinguished alumni, who have signed on to serve as key speakers to share their wisdom with students.

Your support has helped bridge academic studies and practical industry experiences, empowering students striving for excellence in career achievement. Thank you for being a part of this pivotal program. I look forward to connecting with you in the coming year as we engage more students and expand our industry partnerships.

NETWORKING AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

New to our programming this year was a **Career Prep Workshop** series, where students were able to learn skills to enhance their resumes and tailor their internship search with strategies specific to the Economics fields. To give our students additional practice, the workshops also covered how to give an elevator speech, how to prepare for an interview, and allowed participants to take part in mock interviews and practice what they had learned.

We continue to bring a wide variety of industry partners to campus. Recruitment teams from a range of organizations from government agencies like the International Monetary Fund and IRS to banks like Wells Fargo to consulting firms like Boston Consulting Group, all have reached out to organize **annual recruitment events** at UC San Diego to specifically target top talent from our university.

The Industry Engagement program seeks to tap high-caliber companies focused on topical areas including asset and wealth management, investment management, equity research and private equity. Additionally, our alumni volunteers have advised that opportunities at the Treasury could be materially beneficial for students as they embark upon their professional careers post-UC San Diego. Further, Industry Engagement seeks to leverage the San Diego region's unique business community by engaging companies in biotech, hospitality and BlueTech to funnel Triton talent their way.







PLACEMENTS AND POST-GRADUATION OUTCOMES

In year one, we launched post-graduation surveys and started to collect data on internship placements of students throughout the year. Anecdotally, our students have shared that **these programs have been key to their receipt of various internships** throughout the year.
